Delivery: Face to Face or Online

This course is the entry level community services workers who support individuals through the provision of person centered services. Work may include day to day support of individuals in community settings to support the implementation of specific community based programs.

It is a great starting point to prepare students for the work in community services. At this level work takes place under the direction of others and supervision may be direct or indirect.

Work is undertaken in a range of community contexts and provides workers with direct contact with clients, identify presenting needs, referral to support services and provide support as required. They will learn about advocacy, community development, client needs and teamwork.


